

Freedom Hunt – How to secure your hunting license for **RESIDENTS OF INDIANA** (press “control” and “enter” on the blue links below)

1. All licenses must be purchased and the license number emailed to volunteer, BRENDA LOUTHAIN, AT OR NEAR THE TIME OF COMPLETION OF THE REGISRTATION FORM, at dnrico315@yahoo.com. Any questions re licensing should be directed to Brenda at the email address above.
2. Go to Access Indiana portal and create and account at the following link: <https://www.in.gov/access/>
3. Click on the “sign up for your account link” and follow instructions (**note:** you must set up an online account before you can purchase a license. If you have previously purchased a license, you may skip to step 3 below.)
4. After setting up your online account, go to IN DNR online portal page by clicking the following link: <https://www.in.gov/dnr/fish-and-wildlife/indiana-fish-and-wildlife-online-license-system/>
5. Click “enter online portal” on the green bar in the middle of the page
6. On the top right of the page, “login” to your account (this will take you to the Access Indiana page and require your account username and password
7. After logging into your individual account, click on the link titled “purchase licenses.”

8. Residents who have completed hunter safety through the INDNR will only be required to purchase an ***Resident youth hunt/trap license (\$12)***.
9. Residents who have not completed hunter safety will need to purchase the ***Apprentice Resident Youth Hunt/Trap license (\$12)***.

****Note: Any minor, resident or non-resident, may only purchase a total of 3 apprentice licenses before reaching the age of 18. Any minor who intends to hunt deer in Indiana after having purchased 3 apprentice licenses must complete a Hunter's Safety Education Course sanctioned/certified by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources.
