Freedom Hunt – How to secure your hunting license for **<u>RESIDENTS OF INDIANA</u>** (press "control" and "enter" on the blue links below)

- All licenses must be purchased and the license number emailed to volunteer, BRENDA LOUTHAIN, AT OR NEAR THE TIME OF COMPLETION OF THE REGISRTATION FORM, at dnrico315@yahoo.com. Any questions re licensing should be directed to Brenda at the email address above.
- 2. Go to Access Indiana portal and create and account at the following link: <u>https://www.in.gov/access/</u>
- 3. Clink on the "sign up for your account link" and follow instructions (**note**: you must set up an online account before you can purchase a license. If you have previously purchased a license, you may skip to step 3 below.)
- 4. After setting up your online account, go to IN DNR online portal page by clicking the following link: <u>https://www.in.gov/dnr/fish-and-wildlife/indiana-fish-and-wildlife-online-license-system/</u>
- 5. Click "enter online portal" on the green bar in the middle of the page
- 6. On the top right of the page, "login" to your account (this will take you to the Access Indiana page and require your account username and password
- 7. After logging into your individual account, click on the link titled "purchase licenses."

- 8. Residents <u>who have completed hunter safety</u> through the INDNR will only be required to purchase an *Resident youth hunt/trap license* (\$12).
- 9. Residents <u>who have not completed hunter safety</u> will need to purchase the Apprentice Resident Youth Hunt/Trap license (\$12).

****Note: Any minor, resident or non-resident, may only purchase a total of 3 apprentice licenses before reaching the age of 18. Any minor who intends to hunt deer in Indiana after having purchased 3 apprentice licenses must complete a Hunter's Safety Education Course sanctioned/certified by the Indiana Department of Natural Resources.
