

How to secure a hunting license for **NON-RESIDENTS OF INDIANA** (press “control” and “enter” on the blue links below)

Basic Licensing Requirements for non-residents

-Non-resident youth must have deer license (non-residents are not eligible for the basic youth hunt/fish license)

-Non-resident youth Firearms (buck only) - \$39

-Non resident youth bonus antlerless - \$39

*each non-resident participant must purchase a bonus antlerless license...firearms buck only license are optional

*Freedom Hunt will reimburse participant for the cost of each license upon request

1. All licenses must be obtained and emailed to volunteer, Brenda Louthain AT OR NEAR THE TIME OF COMPLETION OF THE REGISTRATION FORM, at dnrco315@yahoo.com.

2. Go to Access Indiana portal and create and account at the following link: <https://www.in.gov/access/>
3. Click on the “sign up for your account link” and follow instructions (**note**: you must set up an online account before you can purchase a license. If you have previously purchased a license, you may skip to step 3 below.)
4. After setting up your online account, go to IN DNR online portal page by clicking the following link: <https://www.in.gov/dnr/fish-and-wildlife/indiana-fish-and-wildlife-online-license-system/>

5. Click “enter online portal” on the green bar in the middle of the page
6. On the top right of the page, “login” to your account (this will take you to the Access Indiana page and require your account username and password
7. After logging into your individual account, click on the link titled “purchase licenses.” Purchase one or more of the licenses referenced above.
